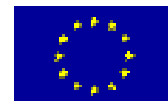

## **1 Preface**

The following document is a CityMobil deliverable which has the status “other”. This means that the deliverable is not a written report, but rather an achievement.

## **2 Description**

The Vantaa (Finland) showcase public operation started on May 9<sup>th</sup> and ended on May 17<sup>th</sup> 2009. The site and vehicle setup for the Vantaa showcase were made from May 2<sup>nd</sup> until May 6<sup>th</sup> 2009. Three two-passengers vehicles were showcased.

Several events were organized in parallel. A press conference was organized on May 7<sup>th</sup>. The City of Vantaa and Techvillia organized a conference titled CityMobil – Future Mobility Solutions, directed to urban planners, on May 8th at the Heureka Science Centre, one of Vantaa’s landmarks. The programme of this conference included a visit to the showcase. Finally, a conference directed to the public was organized at the City Hall on May 9<sup>th</sup>.

In order to explain to the public the goals and benefits of the use of cybercars for urban mobility, the Vantaa showcase featured a new exhibit, prepared in conjunction with the CityNetMobil project, presenting posters, videos, a static cybercar, a Café terrace for the public to fill the questionnaires of the evaluation survey and a dedicated area for the City to exhibit its plans concerning cybercars.
