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1 Preface

The following document is a CityMobil deliverable which has the status “other”. This means that the deliverable is not a written report, but rather the report of an achievement.

2 Description

The Trondheim (Norway) showcase public operation started on August 25th 2009, and ended on August 30th 2009. The site and vehicle setup for the Trondheim showcase were made from August 18th until August 24th 2009. One 6-passengers Automated Guided vehicle and two 2-passengers cybercars were showcased.

Other events organized in parallel included:

- The filming of a science TV show about Transportation Systems automation at the showcase site on August 24th. This TV show was broadcasted while the showcase was still running.
- A press conference on August 25th.
- A conference titled *A driverless future*, directed to urban planners, on August 26th and 27th at the “State’s House” conference centre. The programme of this conference included a visit to the showcase. The conference assistants were taken to the showcase site using electric and hybrid buses.
- Visits for an ITS conference organized by the the Nowegian Road Administration.
- Visits for a group of road safety specialists from the Nowegian Road Administration.

In order to explain to the public the goals and benefits of the use of cybercars in urban transport, the Trondheim showcase featured the CityNetMobil exhibit, prepared initially for the Vantaa showcase. The exhibit presented posters, videos, a static cybercar, a Café terrace for the public to fill the questionnaires of the evaluation survey and a dedicated area for the City to exhibit its plans concerning cybercars.
